Schedule of Events

Thursday: Walking tours, including a cruise on a Washington State Ferry, will be offered in the morning and afternoon. No prior registration is required, but participants must have sufficient funds to pay their own ferry passage.

Semi-guided tours on Seattle's Monorail to the Seattle Center and Space Needle will also be offered in the morning and afternoon. Your guide will help you negotiate Seattle's light rail system to Westlake, where you will board the Monorail. Once at the Seattle Center, your guide will point out attractions such as the Pacific Science Center, the Space Needle, and the Experience Music Project and Science Fiction Museum. No prior registration is necessary, but participants must have sufficient funds to pay their own transportation fares and museum entry fees.

The timing of these tours will allow you to do both trips on the same day or mix them with other activities of your own devising. Details of departure locations, transportation costs, and museum fees will be provided prior to the convention.

Friday: The Thursday tour schedule will be repeated, registration will officially open, and there will be a meeting of the Clients of Adrian Mulliner as well as a Wodehouse Cricket Experience (weather permitting). Lunch and dinner are on your own, but do plan to cap off your evening with the Dessert Buffet and Reception followed by the music of TWS's own Maria Jette and Dan Chouinard.

Saturday: Riveting Talks by Wodehouse experts will be presented. Wodehouse Widow(er)s are invited to join Seattlite Jennifer Psmith on a trip to the Seattle Wine Outlet, where one of the City's premier experts will preside over a tasting of local wines. Prior registration *is* required for this event (see the other side of this form). Lunch will be on your own. In the evening there will be cocktails and, since it is Halloween, a dinner Masquerade. Come in a costume of your own design, or select a mask from the ones that will be provided and decorate it at one of our bejeweling stations.

Sunday: Brunch, a skit by the NEWTS, and fond (and tearful) farewells.

Venue Information

The 18th International Convention of The Wodehouse Society will be held at the Fairmont Olympic Hotel, 411 University Street, Seattle, Washington.

Room reservations must be made directly with the hotel. Phone 1-800-441-1414 and ask for a room in the block for the Wodehouse Convention at the Fairmont Olympic Hotel in Seattle. You can also book online through our direct reservation link: resweb.passkey.com/go/wodehousesociety. Convention room rates are \$199 for single or double occupancy, plus a 15.6% room tax and a \$2 per night Seattle Tourism Assessment fee. Maximum occupancy per room is three people; there is a \$30 per night charge for a third person, but children under 18 staying with parents are free.

Reservations must be made before October 8, 2015.
